 - This includes:
 - a) The avoidance of waste by re-using and recycling materials
 - b) The preservation, restoration and enhancement of the built and natural heritage.
 - c) Encouraging the sustainable use of the land based resources and certified timber and wood products.
- $2. \hspace{0.5cm} \hbox{A general reduction in air, land and water pollution.} \\$
- 3. Ensuring that all vehicles and machines meet emission standards, where possible using unleaded fuel. All equipment will also be properly maintained.
- 4. The use of registered waste disposal companies for removal of all waste streams.
- 5. Ensuring that any cleaning agents that are used are of a biodegradable nature and that any chemicals do not present an environmental hazard
- 6. Limiting to a minimum and the possible elimination of all emissions to the atmosphere e.g. dust
- 7. Restriction in the use of any chemicals that may have a detrimental affect on the ozone layer.
- Limiting to a minimum the use of electricity and gas supplies, and the elimination of wastage. Setting targets for reductions in energy consumption.
- 9. The reduction in the impact of noise crested in environmental sensitive areas.
